The Paris climate agreement is a major step in the commitment of States to fight against climate change. Its implementation calls for local action. **Climate Chance** is the **World Summit** of non-state climate actors, including regions, which are mobilized for this.

Within Climate Chance the **Conference of Peripheral Maritime Regions** (CPMR) organizes a workshop to outline the concrete solutions that European regions are implementing in the area of adaptation to climate change. The workshop will also focus in particular on Integrated Coastal Management, Coastal data, and management of the marine environment.

The experience and commitments from maritime regions will feed into the declaration that will be endorsed by non-state climate actors in view of the COP22 in Marrakech in November 2016. The declaration will be presented at the closing plenary session on 28 September at 14:00-15:30.
