





- 1. Identification of the main research & innovation and industrial initiatives and capabilities within the different Med Countries Regions,
- Identification of promising cross-regional value-chain synergies that could boost bioeconomy and cross-sectorial exchange of resources and products,
- 3. Commonly agreed classification system for Circular Economy initiatives,
- Consideration of the market value, the social, environmental and economic impact, the innovation relevance, and the environmental/policy relevance,
- 5. Identification of a portfolio of investment instruments for the complementary application of the support given by financial instruments







### **BIOECONOMY: OPPORTUNITIES for MED REGIONS**


- Sustaining the regional stakeholders involved in bioeconomy and circular economy activities in line with the <u>Smart Specialisation</u> of each region
